If the "alternative 1" proposal is used the 100' south of the
Avista line is much too close to houses. At the east end the
100' measures "almost" to one house, not good!! with possible
electricity "fallout" from the lines there and all along the
lines.

The poles will spoil the visual "look" of the area including
the designated Coulee Corridor National Scenic Highway started
in 2005.

If the expansive plan of the Coulee City school building happens
in the next year it will expand toward the north. This would
put the lines with possible electricity "fallout" only some
50 Yards from the school, not good!!

Please consider using the "alternative 2" proposal along the
Main Canal.
