

Olympic Peninsula Transmission Reinforcement

Jan. 11, 2007 public meeting

Attendees: two employees from the City of Shelton

Comments taken at the meeting:

- Some property in this area is proposed to be used for a municipal well site that would be located relatively close to the right-of-way.
- There are some utility lines that run under Washington State Highway 101, near the proposed project.
- Our urban growth rate is outpacing your estimates for increased power demand in the area.
- When you reinforce the Port Angeles area, will you have to come back and build additional power lines or upgrade others in our area?
- When would construction begin?
- There is a large commercial/residential development proposed for the area just to the southwest of the Shelton Substation near Goose Lake. The first phase of this development, the commercial phase, could begin as early as this year (2007), with the second phase, as much as 1000 residential housing units, beginning in 2008.
- Do you ever sell your fee-owned land?
- What are the prospects of putting lines underground?
- Would lattice towers only be on the turns?
- We're projecting that a lot of roads that will be built in the area; and
- How are you planning on complying with SEPA?
