

TIERED RATE METHODOLOGY DEFINITIONS

Redlined from July 25 TRM to true up to contracts

Above-RHWM Load means ~~the amount by which a customer's~~ forecast annual Total Retail Load, less Existing Resources, ~~and NLSLs, and exceeds its~~ the customer's RHWM, as determined in the RHWM Process.

Balancing Authority Area means the collection of generation, transmission, and loads within the metered boundaries of the Balancing Authority. ~~The Balancing Authority maintains load resource balance within this area.~~

Block Product means BPA's power product defined in section 4 of a planned amount of BPA firm power service under the Block and/or Slice/Block CHWM Contract.

Designated BPA System Obligations means the set of obligations specified in Table 3.4 imposed on BPA by statutes, treaties, executive orders, and contracts that require the generation or delivery of power, forbearance from generating power, or receipt of power, in order to support the operation of the FCRPS, including any obligations to the BPA Balancing Authority.

Existing Resources means athose Specified Resources listed in section 2 of Exhibit A of a customer's ~~the~~ CHWM Contract that such customer was obligated by contract or statute to use to serve its ~~were dedicated to the Existing Customer's~~ Total Retail Load prior to October 1, 2006.

Resource Support Services or (RSS) presently includes Diurnal Flattening Service (DFS), Forced Outage Reserve Services (FORS), Transmission Curtailment Management Service (TCMS), and Secondary Crediting Service (SCS), and may in the future include other related services that are priced ~~posed~~ in the applicable 7(i) Process.

Super Peak Period means ~~a specific subset of the Heavy Load h~~Hours, defined pursuant to the CHWM Contract for ~~in section 5.3.4, established by BPA before~~ each Rate Period

into which a customer must reshape its HLH energy from its dedicated resources to receive a Super Peak Credit. The hours BPA establishes~~7(i) Process to establish Tier 1 Rates, during which a customer has contractually committed to deliver an amount of additional capacity to qualify~~ for the Super Peak Period may vary by month and will be either two 3-hour periods each day or a single 6-hour period each day~~Credit.~~

Total Retail Load or ~~(TRL)~~ means ~~BPA's forecast of~~ all retail electric power consumption, including electric system losses, within a customer's electrical system, excluding:

- nonfirm or interruptible loads agreed to by BPA and the customer
- , transfer loads of other utilities served by such~~the~~ customer
- , ~~and~~ any loads not on such~~the~~ customer's electrical system and not within such customer's contiguous service territory unless~~that are not~~ specifically agreed to by BPA

-As used in the TRM, TRL is always BPA's forecast of the customer's TRL.
