"Do either of you remember working with or hearing the name Gaylord Kellog? He evidently has some concerns about the line, but I didn't see any comments from him in anything that I had. I am asking because he is also the son-in-law of Bill Ruckelshaus. This is the same Ruckelshaus who served in Nixon's Whitehouse (was one of those fired because he refused to do what Nixon wanted) He is currently head of the Salmon Recovery Board here in Washington. He is quite an influential person politically. Anyway I am willing to make an initial call, but didn't want to do that if we have received correspondence from him already or have already had a conversation with him. He has a Seattle number.
