Dear Mr. Detzel:

On January 28, 2003, our office provided you with a response to your request for all written or electronic communications between Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and Northwest members of congress during the period from December 31, 2000 to the present.

Our January 28 response provided you with copies of communications that BPA sent to the Northwest members of congress, but we inadvertently failed to include copies of communications BPA received from the Northwest members of congress. Enclosed with this letter are the non-exempt portions of the communications BPA inadvertently failed to include with its January 28 response.

BPA has determined that individual identifying information, such as private citizens names, addresses, phone numbers, and social security numbers, are exempt from disclosure under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) (exemption 6) of the FOIA; therefore this information has been redacted from the enclosed documents. Please refer to our January 28 response for an analysis of the reasons this type of information is exempt from disclosure and for information concerning your appeal rights.
