Thank you for the letter received December 4 requesting documents regarding a windmill proposal. The request has been logged in as #03-013.

Specifically, you asked for an unsolicited proposal submitted by Renewable Generation Inc. of Texas. The proposal was to sell energy produced from a set of windmills to Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) from a project to be built on the Oregon coast in Tillamook County. You asked for a copy of the proposal and any associated information about the project.

Your follow-up fax indicated a willingness to pay all appropriate costs and asked that should the costs exceed \$15 dollars that we call you with an estimate before proceeding.
