FOIA Request

This is a FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) request related to the Telephone Flat and Fourmile Hill Geothermal Projects located on the Modoc and Klamath National Forest.

1. Any available documentation on where the power generated for above projects will be going.
2. Correspondence with Calpine Cooperation
3. Criteria for Green Energy certification for Bonneville Power projects.
4. Correspondence with Klamath, Modoc, and BLM in relation to above projects

KS Wild will use the information to monitor the Klamath, Modoc, Rogue, Siskiyou NF's compliance with the Constitution of the United States of America and the laws and regulations pertaining to the closure of public lands to the public and the media. KS Wild has an established interest in the Medicine Lake region and the Telephone Flat Geothermal Project.

Public understanding of government activities will be enhanced by release of the requested information, both through KS Wild's advocacy and its ongoing monitoring of federal actions. The requested information is not circulated in the public domain.

KS Wild staff has demonstrated familiarity with the laws governing federal land access and regularly disseminates the style of information requested above. KS Wild will distribute its analysis of =46S activities, based in part on this information request, through local, national and international journals, magazines, newspapers, radio, television, and internet. KS Wild produces a quarterly newsletter with a national circulation of over 6,000.

KS Wild is registered with the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and will not use the information for any commercial purpose. KS Wild is therefore entitled to a fee waiver pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A)(iii).

If a fee waiver is not granted, we request permission to personally review all responsive information and select what we want copied.

We await your reply within 20 working days, as required by 5 U.S.C.

552(a)(6)(A). Please notify us well in advance of the statutory response deadline if we can clarify or narrow the scope of this request.
