Thank you for the fax of August 6, 2003, requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Specifically, you've requested:

- 1) All inter and intra agency correspondence with any congressional representatives, senators, or their aids concerning implementation of reasonable and prudent alternatives prescribed in the December 20, 2000 biological opinion related to operations of Libby Dam and protection of the Korean River Sturgeon.
- 2) Any documents or correspondence concerning measures necessary to transmit power from additional turbines at Libby Dam, particularly those related to the Elmo-Kerr project.
