Dear Ms Eissler:

I am a researcher for the Concerned Coos Citizens. The CCC, under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 USC 552, would like copies of the following documents regarding the Roseburg-Coos Bay gas pipeline project, whose owner is Coos County, and whose construction contractor is MasTec.

Documents in any form, including but not limited to field reports and notes, investigations, photos, reports, computer documents, and phone notes describing any inspection of the area of the pipeline's construction, including but not limited to areas in or near the Right of Way.

Any documents mentioning the discharges or spills of drilling muds or any other pollutants at any locations related to the pipeline's construction, including observations, reports, and sampling results of waters and/or soils/sediments, including but not limited to break-outs of drilling muds during directional drilling of Middle and Cherry Creeks, the

Coquille River, and/or discharges of excavated soils into the drainage area of Cherry Creek.

Any documents describing the project's compliance or non-compliance with BPA Right of Way requirements.

Any documents in any form describing your agency's permission to the owner and their contractor to perform in-stream work until September 15, and any documents or correspondence describing any decisions or discussion to extend the date for the in-stream work.

All correspondence between your agency, MasTec, and Coos County, since June 1, 2003.

Thank you very much for your cooperation. Please provide copies of these documents within the time periods described by law.
