Thank you for the electronic request of January 22, 2003 requesting documents under provisions of the Freedom of Information Act. Your request was received by me on January 27, 2003 and has been logged in as #03-017.

Specifically, you asked for documents relating to design and construction of the BPA lines which cross the Columbia River in close proximity to the BPA Midway Substation; documents relating to communications with the Civil Aeronautics Administration, the Atomic Energy Commission or any other entity regarding lighting/marketing these lines; any documents regarding lighting/marketing BPA's lines which cross the Columbia River within this grouping of seven; and any other FOIA Requests for information submitted by Clifton Dyer or Kennewick Aircraft Services or their attorney, Miller & Associates; the Estates of Kathleen Cheap and James Michael Callow or their attorney, Myers & Knapp or Osborn Smith.

You indicated a willingness to pay reasonable costs required by FOIA up to \$500. You further asked that we call you if costs exceed this amount so that you may obtain authorization for additional payment.
