This letter is to request, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, the following:

- 1) Copies of any and all documents produced in response to any Freedom of Information Act requests of the Grant County P.U.D. and/or its attorney, David Sonn of Jeffers, Danielson, Sonn & Aylward.
- 2) Copies of any and all documents, including correspondence, memos, emails, graphs, charts, etc. from and to the Grant County P.U.D. from the Bonneville Power Administration concerning the BPA and Grant County utility lines located at the Vernita Crossing.
- 3) Any and all documents, reports, memos, computer runs, notes, charts, graphs, etc. that provide a basis for determining the number, type and extent of all aircraft flying low-level missions (below 500 feet AGL) under the supervision of the Bonneville Power Administration, along, or near, the Columbia River, and/or within a 20 mile radius of the crossing of the Columbia at the Vernita Bridge. This request is intended to encompass all low-level flight activity from any O Bonneville Power Administration' supervised flights, including the Bureau of Land Management, Fish and Wildlife, United States Geological Survey, etc. This request is intended to encompass low-level flight activities for all years commencing from 1990 to the present.


