1. A copy of any advertisements, requests for qualifications, invitations or solicitations published or disseminated by BPA prior to selecting a hearing officer for the Safety-Net Cost Recovery Adjustment Clause (SN-CRAC) rate case.
2. A copy of the contract and statement of work between BPA and Allan J. Arlow for services related to his serving as the hearing officer for the SN-CRAC rate case.
3. Correspondence, memorandum, e-mails or other communication, whether written or electronic, between BPA and Mr. Arlow relating to his selection and services to be performed pursuant to the above contract.
4. Correspondence, memorandum, e-mails or other communication, whether written or electronic, between BPA's Office of General Counsel and BPA's Purchasing/Contracts Office relating to the contract with Mr. Arlow. Included in the scope of this item are any directives or requests to the Purchasing/Contracts Office to execute a contract with Mr. Arlow without going through a competitive procurement.

Your request was received by our office on June 6, 2003 and has been logged in as FOIA #03-028.

You have agreed to pay for costs up to \$50 and asked that if costs for your request exceed \$50, that we call you before proceeding.
