This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated January 12, 2004 and designated as FOIA #04-013.

1. You have requested a copy of all contracts between BPA and any vendor to help with governmental relations, etc.

Response: With the exception of the contract issued to Washington2 Advocates, BPA has not issued any contracts for such services. It is my understanding that a copy of the Washington2Advocates contract has been provided to you.

2. You have requested information regarding the amount of money expended in each fiscal year for the firms listed above.

Response: As indicated above, no other contracts were issued for this service during the time period you requested. For Washington2 Advocates, a copy of their payment information is attached to this letter. I have summarized payments by Fiscal Year in the margin.
