Dear Mr. Berlin:

This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated February 27, 2004, designated as FOIA #04-027.

Specifically, you requested copies of several BPA wind power purchase contracts for Condon, Klondike, and Stateline wind projects. Your letter states that you would like these contracts to aid the Northern California Power Agency (NCPA) in its process of acquiring wind resources of its own.

In response to your request, the following materials are enclosed. These documents are in their redacted form, which still should satisfy your information needs:

- 1) Contract number 00PB-10692, power purchase agreement for the Condon Wind Power Project, executed on November 7, 2001, including substantive revisions or exhibits since its execution date, and the exhibit for its generation interconnection agreement, BPA contract number 01TX-10554;
- 2) Contract number 01PB-10761, power purchase agreement for the Stateline Wind project, executed on December 13, 2001, including substantive revisions or exhibits since its execution date; and
- 3) Contract number 01PB-11093, power purchase agreement for the Klondike Wind project, executed on June 4, 2002, including substantive revisions or exhibits since its execution date.

These documents are in redacted form, mostly without certain financial information. You state that you are not seeking confidential and pricing information contained in the contracts, as you are seeking contract terms used by other parties with wind resource projects as examples to consider as NCPA investigates the purchase of wind resources.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, D.C. 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal".
