Dear Ms. White:

On April 5, 2004, the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) received a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request from you dated March 29, 2004, which BPA has designated as No. 04-035. In such request you asked for "access to and copies of hourly generation data for the Federal Columbia River Power System (FCRPS) Hydro Projects for the time period January 1, 1995 to March 31, 2004." You affirmed in your request that you "do not need or want hourly data for individual projects, but for the system as a whole."

The requested data is enclosed in a 3.5-inch floppy disc, which, in a conversation with Rod Boling on April 19, 2004, you affirmed as your preferred source. There is no other material responsive to your request. There is no fee for the provided data.

If you are dissatisfied with this response, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, D.C. 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal".
