Dear Mr. Love:

We are in receipt of your letter dated June 9, 2004, requesting a status report on the disposition of our response to your Freedom of Information Act request (BPA log # FOIA 04-037). In the referenced FOIA request, you asked for copies of BPA records regarding acquisition and project proposals and any other related documents from the Albeni Falls Wildlife Mitigation Work Group, including the Idaho Department of Fish and Wildlife, The Kalispel Tribe of Indians, The Coeur d'Alene Tribe, the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho, the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, Natural Resources Conservation Service or any other group participating in acquisitions for the mitigation program, to the BPA for acquisition consideration from January 1, 2000 to the date we entered your request into our FOIA Log (May 25, 2004). You also requested copies of correspondence or other records dated from January 1, 2004 through the date we entered your request into our FOIA Log detailing acquisition activities between the BPA and any or all agencies named as parties in the Albeni Falls Wildlife Mitigation Program. In addition, you requested copies of any BPA documents and correspondence for the Albeni Falls Wildlife Mitigation Program that includes policy, timelines, public involvement, etc., as of January 1, 2003 through the present.

Your request was received by our office on April 27, 2004 and was logged in as FOIA #04-037.

Since April 27, 2004, you had telephone conversations with BPA authorizing official, Mr. Lee Watts, Fish and Wildlife Project Manager. During your telephone conversations with Mr. Watts, he provided you with names of contacts at other organizations, e.g., NEPA and tribes that might be of assistance to you. In addition, Mr. Watts emailed you on May 14th, providing you with two

BPA website links that contain all responsive records that BPA has regarding your request. The two websites are:
