Thank you for your letter of October 17, 2003 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act. In your letter you requested the following:


1. Copies of any environmental assessments or impact analyses prepared by Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) or BPA contractors to evaluate the potential environmental consequences of the action to increase power levels from 230 kv to 500 kv on BPA lines between Monroe and Sno-King.
2. Maps of all 500 kv lines in Washington state and/or addresses of their substations, and any programmatic environment assessments of 500 kv lines created by BPA or BPA contractors.

Your request was received by our office on October 21, 2003 and has been logged in as FOIA #04-002.
