This request includes individuals or firms hired to acquire information for BPA through regular contacts with members of Congress, or to help BPA in its communications with Congress, the U.S. Department of Energy, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, the White House staff or any other federal office or entity.
2. The amount of money expended in each fiscal year for each individual or firm listed in number 1 above.

I have previously received information regarding a 2001 consulting contract between BPA and Tony Williams and the Washington2 Advocates firm (see FOIA #04-06).

This request is for other consultants who have contracted with BPA to perform tasks, as described above, since October 1, 1999.
