In your letter you request Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) provide you with copies of any records relative to the repair or replacement of a steel ground wire on a BPA transmission line that occurred as the result of a helicopter strike on August 3, 1974, over the Siuslaw River near Mapleton, Oregon.
