

1 QUALIFICATION STATEMENT OF

2 MEGAN T. CAPPER

3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Megan T. Capper. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration  
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am a Public Utilities Specialist in the Transmission and Reserve Services group for the  
9 Power Business Line (PBL).

10 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

11 A. I received a B.A. degree in Economics from Willamette University in 1988 and a MBA from  
12 the University of Washington in 1993.

13 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

14 A. In February 1989 I began work at BPA in the Division of Energy Resources. In that  
15 capacity I prepared end-use metered data and analyses in support of market forecasting,  
16 power marketing, and energy conservation planning.

17 In September 1991 I began work in BPA's Seattle Area Office. Among other  
18 analytical support, I assisted in the development of conservation utility plans, defining  
19 effective conservation, and outlining 10-year implementation plans for achieving  
20 conservation potential.

21 In September 1994 I joined the Non-Generating Public Segment tasked to develop  
22 BPA's marketing strategy for its non-generating customers. I worked with BPA's  
23 environmental, legal, sales, and operational staff members to identify and resolve,  
24 non-generation public load commitment and rate case issues.

25 In July 1995 I began participating in the development of the Ancillary and Reserve  
26 Services group. This entailed an understanding of Federal Energy Regulatory Commission

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1 and North American Electric Reliability Council policies and regulations concerning these  
2 issues, and following industry changes. In this capacity, I currently serve as project lead  
3 developing pricing methodologies for long- and short-term reserve service sales and  
4 supporting PBL in ancillary/reserve service issue resolution.

5 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*
