

1 QUALIFICATION STATEMENT OF

2 CRAIG R. LARSON

3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Craig R. Larson. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am a Hydraulic Engineer in the Regional Coordination group for the Power Business Line.

9 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

10 A. I received a B.S. degree in Economics from the University of Oregon in 1983, and a
11 B.S. degree in Engineering from Portland State University in 1987. My field of
12 concentration at Portland State University was water resources.

13 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

14 A. In May 1987, I began work at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE), Portland District. I
15 occupied two positions: (1) an assignment with the Plan Formulation group conducting
16 recognizance and feasibility studies of public works proposals; and (2) an assignment with
17 the Hydrology Section of the Hydrologic and Hydraulic Engineering Branch conducting
18 hydrologic studies.

19 In 1991, I joined BPA in the Canadian Treaty section of the Resource Planning
20 Branch. During the following three years, I assisted in the production and study of the
21 Assured Operating Plans, the six-year advance planning document that implements the
22 requirements of the Columbia River Treaty that plans the operation of Mica, Arrow, and
23 Duncan reservoirs in Canada.

24 In 1994, I joined the Reservoir Control Center at the COE, North Pacific Division.
25 In this capacity, I planned, scheduled, and implemented operations of the COE reservoirs in
26 the Columbia and Snake River basins.

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1 Beginning in July 1997, I joined BPA, again, in my current position in the Regional
2 Coordination group. My areas of responsibilities include: (1) conducting the Treaty Storage
3 Regulation, mid-term planning of Columbia River Treaty projects; (2) assisting the studies
4 of fishery operations evaluating energy impacts of proposed operations; (3) planning and
5 designing a set of performance indicators in operation of COE generation facilities
6 consistent with the requirements of the COE Direct Funding Memorandum of Agreement;
7 and (4) assembling information required by the Pacific Northwest Coordination Agreement
8 Data Submittal process for inclusion in BPA's preliminary and modified data submittals.
9 I have been registered with the State of Oregon as a Professional Engineer (#14470), since
10 July 26, 1989, after fulfilling the necessary requirements.

11 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*
