4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Timothy R. Smith. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am the Manager for Regional Coordination in the Resource Optimization group of the
9 Power Business Line.

10 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

11 A. I received a B.S. degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Arizona in 1980.

12 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

13 A. From 1981 until 1983, I worked for the U.S. Forest Service as a Geotechnical Engineer.

14 From 1984 until 1985, I developed software for BPA's Real-Time Operations,
15 Dispatch and Scheduling (RODS) computer.

16 From 1986 to 1987, I worked for BPA on Pacific Northwest Coordination
17 Agreement (PNCA) planning.

18 From 1988 to 1989, I worked for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, designing,
19 testing and purchasing automation systems.

20 From 1989 to 1990, I worked for BPA in PNCA planning.

21 From 1990 to 1992, I managed BPA's RODS software development group in Power
22 Supply.

23 From 1993 to 1995, I managed BPA's short-term contract administration section and
24 the start-up of BPA's trading floor.

25 From 1996 to 1997, I worked on BPA's negotiation of the Canadian Entitlement
26 return.

1 From 1998 to present, I managed Regional Coordination. The Regional
2 Coordination group is responsible for determining the costs and operational impacts of
3 proposed fish operations; Columbia River Treaty planning; PNCA planning; long-term
4 inventory planning; the Pacific Northwest Loads and Resources Study (White Book), and;
5 the loads and resources data for rate cases. I have been a registered professional Civil
6 Engineering with the State of Oregon since 1985.
