3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Jeffrey W. Chow. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am a Senior Risk Analyst in the Power Business Risk Management group for the Power
9 Business Line (PBL).

10 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

11 A. I received a M.S. degree in Decision Science/Statistics from the University of Oregon in
12 1993, a B.A. in Mathematics and a B.A. in Economics from the University of California at
13 Santa Cruz in 1991.

14 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

15 A. From January 1994 to February 1997, I worked for Bonneville Power as a Mathematician in
16 the Financial Services division. I developed programs and worked on optimizing BPA's
17 debt repayment. In that same time period, I also worked as a Financial Analyst consultant
18 for Economic & Engineering Consultants.

19 From March 1997 to July 1999, I worked for Deutsche Bank/Bankers Trust
20 Corporation. As a Vice President of Global Portfolio Risk Management, I ensured the
21 oversight of market risk exposures for North American Equity Derivatives, Program
22 Trading, and Global Convertible Bonds. Market risk for the North American option markets
23 include oversight over the New York and Canadian regions. I worked with derivative
24 traders involved with Global convertible bonds trading worldwide markets out of Bankers
25 Trust International London trading floor and Bankers Trust Alex Brown New York trading
26 floor.

1 From August 1999 to present, I have been a Senior Risk Analyst for BPA.

2 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*

3 *A. I testified for BPA's 1995 and 1996 Rate Case in the area of debt repayment.*

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
