POSITION LOCATION: The position is in the Transmission Product Management & Market Analysis (TSBM) organization of Commercial Policy and Implementation (TSB), Transmission Marketing and Sales (TS), Transmission Services (T), Bonneville Power Administration (BPA).

WHO MAY APPLY: Bonneville Power Administration employees currently at GS-09, GS-11 and GS-12 are encouraged to apply.

NOTES: Selection from this announcement is subject to the requirements of applicable personnel regulations, policies, and BPA HR Directives. There is no promotion associated with this interest announcement (i.e., employee will retain their current rate of pay)

- When an employee already holds the same grade or higher as the position of interest on a permanent basis, then the detail may be made for a period up to one year, in 120-day increments. When appropriate, details may be extended for an additional year, in 120-day increments.
- When an employee holds a lower graded position or is in a position with lower-graded promotion potential than the position of interest, he/she is prohibited from serving in a higher-graded position for more than 120-days in a 52-week period.
- The employee will be returned to his/her permanent position of record (i.e., position prior to detail) upon completion of the detail opportunity.

GENERAL INFORMATION: The incumbent will report to *TSBM Supervisory Public Utilities Specialist*

There are two vacancies. One will support the Ancillary Services product and product manager; the other will support the Generation Interconnection product and product manager.

The purpose of this position is to serve as a Product Management Specialist responsible for planning, coordinating and implementing all product processes with product managers and market analysts in support of identified products. The incumbent supports lifecycle and the strategy, roadmap, and feature definition for products or product lines. Specific responsibilities include development, administration, management,

and documentation of product management processes so that the organization maintains consistency of approach and ultimately results. The incumbent works with the supporting market analysis function assessing, on an ongoing basis, market and competitive conditions, their impacts on products and lays out a product vision that is differentiated and delivers unique value based on customer demands. The incumbent also supports the product manager's responsibilities for marketing, forecasting, and meeting objectives set for the product. The incumbent maintains relationships and interfaces with all value chain participants.

DUTIES:

- Coordinates the development, production, distribution of relevant assigned product performance reports, including the monthly and annual reports. Works with the relevant product manager to identify the key variables unique for their product that will be summarized, coordinates inputs with the appropriate value chain participants.
- For specifically identified products, assists and leads, as required, in the understanding of customer requirements, defining and prioritizing them, and leading line organization teams to build, operate and improve them as necessary.
- Develops and presents issues, business practices, and procedures for the organization in support of mission function, objectives, and established business line targets.
- Works directly with TSBM product manager and market analyst leads on work assignments.
- Analyzes industry and regulatory trends and advises BPA management on potential future industry directions, especially related to new generation and load service.

SPECIAL SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Knowledge of transmission commercial operations and transmission products is desirable.
