This is an opportunity to express your interest to serve under a detail assignment, not-to-exceed 240 days (in increments of not-to-exceed 120 days), as the Vice President, Bulk Marketing, a Senior Executive Service position reporting to the Senior Vice President, Power Services. This is an interest announcement for a detail; no pay change is associated with selection under this announcement. Details may be terminated at any time based on the needs of management. At the end of the detail, you will be returned to your original position of record, or to a different position of equivalent grade and pay.

WHO MAY APPLY:

Current BPA Employees with competitive status at GS-15 level.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Vice President for Bulk Marketing reports to the Senior Vice President for Power Services. Bonneville Power Administration's Bulk Marketing organization's areas of responsibility include transacting with Pacific Northwest (PNW) wholesale marketers; utilities outside the PNW; and all active wholesale marketers and brokers in the Western Systems Coordinating Council (WSCC), both inside and outside the PNW, including Canadian and California markets. The function represents Power Services in market design and policy forums and acts as Power Services' liaison with Western Electric Coordination Council (WECC), Western System Power Pool (WSPP), and market operator(s) in the West including the real-time and day-ahead markets of the California Independent System Operator (CAISO). Bulk Marketing is responsible for trading floor activities and spot market sales totaling approximately \$335 million per year on a total market of \$3 billion. Scheduling and Trading functions include a full range of forward, pre-schedule and real-time activities. The transmission and reserve services functions include the purchase or sale of transmission and reserve services including product development, pricing, and inventory control and reporting. This function is responsible for providing market expertise and intelligence in the areas of natural gas, carbon markets and trading, California markets, renewable resources and renewable energy credits. The incumbent provides executive leadership in the planning, development, and administration of the overall Power sales and customer service program, in close cooperation with the Vice President for Requirements Marketing.

Specific responsibilities and duties would include:

This position serves as the Vice President for Bulk Marketing for BPA, which is a key member of the BPA executive leadership team. The incumbent directs Bulk Marketing organizational activities, frames strategic plans based on broad organizational assessments and evaluations of long-term organizational objectives. They determine the financial and personnel resources

needed to achieve mission objectives and support mission operations; identify the need for major organizational improvements and develop the requisite plans and direct implementing actions.

The incumbent manages and directs the internal organization, staffing, policies, and personnel authorities required to carry out the responsibilities of the organization, including the recruitment of senior managers and technical experts necessary to ensure the success of the programs.

The Vice President for Bulk Marketing provides executive leadership in the planning, development, fiscal oversight and administration of programs, systems, and processes which are functionally critical for Bonneville to manage and oversee its long and short-term marketing of surplus power including reserve services marketing, transmission acquisition, resource acquisition, and power scheduling.

Qualifications:

Candidates must possess the following:

1. Demonstrated ability to manage bulk power marketing and purchasing in a hydro-dependent utility environment.
2. Development of public policies related to wholesale power marketing.
3. Demonstrated ability to manage the development, negotiation and administration of wholesale power contracts.
