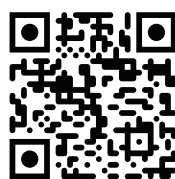
Who is eligible to apply?

Internship Program: Current undergraduate and graduate college students from accredited education institutions or a qualifying career or technical education program may apply.

Applicants must be enrolled at least part time in college or an educational program while working as a student trainee.

Recent Graduate Program: Applicants must have graduated within the last two years with a degree or certificate from a qualifying educational institution, or career or technical education institution to apply. Veterans may apply for up to six years after a degree completion.
