

Contractor Training Requirements

For Contract Workers with Physical or Logical Access

To help ensure the health and safety of BPA's workforce, network, facilities and assets, BPA requires all personnel to complete training as outlined below. Required training guidelines are determined by the type of access that has been granted. For questions, contact the BPA COR, if applicable.

NOTE: The information below is as of 1/15/2026 and may be updated quarterly.

Initial Training	Training is provided via a PDF self-study guide.			All training courses listed under the Logical Access header below must be completed in Learning Nucleus within the initial training period specified or as directed by the COR. ⁵				
Training Cadence	Annual: Self-study guide will be distributed early in the calendar year and the Training Attestation must be completed no later than March 15 th each year.			Quarterly: BPA posts the required trainings that are due each quarter. Trainings must be completed in the quarter they are due; they should not be completed ahead of schedule. ⁵				
Training Records	Training attestations are uploaded biweekly to BPA's system of record. Workers and/or suppliers are encouraged to retain a copy as well.			Training certificates transfer to BPA in a nightly automated data transfer. Workers should download and save training certificates for their records. Once all trainings are complete, workers should notify their COR.

⁴ Training is required to be completed during the initial training period only. It is not repeated annually.

⁵ Required courses may change at the Department of Energy's (DOE) discretion. Additional courses may be required.
