To: Parties Interested in the Big Eddy-Knight Transmission Project

In June 2009, the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) sent notification to the public about a proposal to build a new transmission line and substation, along with plans to prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) for the project. We asked for your comments on the project and hosted two public meetings. Thank you for taking the time to tell us your thoughts and concerns.

In response to the comments we received and additional preliminary design work, we have further refined the proposed project. The enclosed fact sheet explains these refinements, summarizes the comments we received, outlines our next steps and provides contact information for additional input or questions you may have.

Because of these refinements, additional landowners may be impacted by the proposed project and we may need to ask for permission to enter property where we do not have existing access. We will contact those property owners for permission to enter property through a separate mailing from our Real Property Field Services Office.
