To: Parties interested in the Kalispell-Kerr Transmission Line Rebuild Project

Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) has prepared a draft environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed Kalispell-Kerr Transmission Line Rebuild Project. The draft EA describes the project and why it is needed, discusses the environmental impacts the project would create and lists the mitigation measures that would lessen or eliminate those impacts. This letter requests your comments on the EA and outlines the next steps for the project.

BPA proposes to rebuild the 41-mile, 115-kilovolt Kalispell-Kerr wood-pole transmission line between Kalispell and Polson, Montana. The line was originally built in 1947 and is showing normal deterioration due to age. The rebuild would involve replacing all wood-pole structures (including poles, cross arms, cross braces, guys, anchors and insulator assemblies); replacing conductors and ground wires; and improving access roads. If BPA decides to proceed with the project, construction would begin in the summer of 2017.
