## To: People Interested in the Kalispell-Kerr Transmission Line Rebuild Project

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) has finalized the environmental assessment (EA) for the Kalispell-Kerr Transmission Line Rebuild Project. Based on the final EA, BPA is issuing a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) and has made a decision to proceed with the project. This letter describes BPA's decision, the construction schedule, and how to obtain additional information.

**Background**: BPA will rebuild the 41-mile, 115-kilovolt Kalispell-Kerr wood-pole transmission line between Kalispell and Polson, Montana. The project is necessary due to the overall age and condition of the line. BPA will rebuild the line using generally the same structure locations; pole heights will be 10 to 15 feet taller to accommodate a new overhead ground wire and to conform to current safety standards. Improvements will involve replacing all wood-pole structures, replacing conductors and ground wires, and improving access roads.

BPA prepared an EA to help the agency determine if the Proposed Action would cause significant impacts that would warrant preparation of an environmental impact statement. BPA released the draft EA for public review and comment in February 2016 and received comments from eight entities. The final EA provides responses to those comments and minor revisions to the EA. Based on the EA analysis and mitigation measures, BPA has found that the Proposed Action will not cause any significant impacts. Therefore, an environmental impact statement will not be prepared.

**Decision**: BPA has decided to proceed with the Proposed Action and will rebuild the Kalispell-Kerr line as described in the final EA. Project construction is expected to begin in spring 2017 and continue until winter 2018, with a break in construction during the winter months.
