To: People Interested in the Lemhi Valley River and Floodplain Restoration Projects

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) is proposing to fund multiple river and stream restoration projects in the Lemhi River Valley. This letter explains what is being proposed, outlines our environmental review process and schedule, and requests your comments.

Proposal: The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) proposes to provide funding for river and floodplain habitat restoration actions in the mainstem and tributaries of the Lemhi River in eastern Idaho designed to benefit fish species such as Chinook salmon, steelhead, and bull trout. These actions include six mainstem and tributary river/stream restoration actions; four irrigation diversion modifications; one bridge construction; and planting, riparian-protection fencing, invasive weed treatments, and hydroseeding (a planting process using a slurry of seed and mulch) at various locations within the Lemhi River Valley.

Environmental Review: To understand the potential environmental impacts of this proposal, BPA will prepare an environmental assessment (EA). The EA will describe anticipated impacts to natural and human resources and include mitigation measures that would help avoid or minimize impacts. We are asking for your comments to help determine the issues that should be addressed in the EA. During this process, BPA will work with Federal, state, and local agencies, Tribes, potentially affected landowners, and other interest groups. The proposed schedule for the EA process is as follows:
