To: People interested in the Radio System Upgrades at Willow Creek Summit and Windy Devil Annex

Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) has finalized the environmental assessment (EA) for the Radio System Upgrades at Willow Creek Summit and Windy Devil Annex. Based on the final EA, BPA is issuing a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) and has made a decision to proceed with the project. This letter describes BPA's decision, the construction schedule, and how to obtain additional information.

Background: BPA will have two radio stations built in Custer County, Idaho: one at Willow Creek Summit on Bureau of Land Management- (BLM) managed land, and one at Windy Devil on U.S. Forest Service-managed land. The project will provide greater reliability and coverage of the Very High Frequency (VHF) two-way radio system used by BPA field personnel, thereby enhancing the safety of the Federal Columbia River Transmission System.

BPA and the BLM prepared an EA to help the agencies determine if the project would cause significant impacts that would warrant preparing an environmental impact statement. The agencies released the draft EA for public review and comment in June 2021 and received joint comments from two Idaho state agencies. The final EA provides responses to those comments and highlights minor revisions to the Draft EA. Based on the EA analysis and mitigation measures to help lessen impacts, BPA and the BLM have found that the project will not cause any significant impacts and, therefore, an environmental impact statement will not be prepared.

Decision: BPA has decided to construct the Radio System Upgrades at Willow Creek Summit and Windy Devil Annex. Project construction is expected to begin in June 2022 and continue through October 2023, with breaks in construction during seasonal restrictions.
