Sept. 5, 2025, marks the final day to submit LC6.0 projects into BPA Energy Efficiency Tracking System (BEETS). Any non-residential lighting project submitted after that will utilize the Online Lighting Calculator (OLC). Each utility's transition timeline and calculator preference will differ based on various factors.
