Draft results from 2016 billing analysis are low compared to RTF estimates

Data collection activities:


- End user survey (phone land web) of a sample of projects

Next Steps

Mid-May	Draft survey circulated for utility comment

Mid-June	Survey pre-tested
End of June	Survey instrument, contact lists, and call center talking points sent to utilities Advanced letters mailed to end-users (optional)

Opt-In Billing Analysis

Why Opt-In Billing Analysis?

DHP Zonal

- Proven measure, not under review, yet
- Utility interest in understanding savings in their territory

DHP eFAF

- Draft results from 2016 billing analysis are low compared to RTF estimates
- Add'l sample to:
 - improve precision on results
 - east side utility representation

Prescriptive Duct Sealing

- Draft results from 2016 billing analysis are not statistically significant
- Add'l sample to make results meaningful

How to Provide Your Billing Data

Thank you for participating in our opt-in billing data analysis!

Please use this workbook to provide your billing data. Specifically, use the data collection tab(s) for the measure(s) for which you want to provide your project energy consumption data, as well as the Quick Data Clarifications' tab to provide some quick clarifications that will help our team better understand your data and reduce our follow-up questions.

Instructions

Beyond the FAQs below, our team is standing by to help! Please don't hesitate to reach out to Kuldeep More, 360-828-4016, kuldeep.more@navigant.com with any question.

Which projects are eligible? Eligible projects are any projects installed between 1/2015 and 8/2016.

What dates do we need? Please provide billing data from two years prior to 'Completion Date' to the most current data available for each site.

If it's easier for you, we're happy to receive billing data beginning in 10/1/2014 through present for all measures.

Key fields on the data collection tabs. Please provide a unique end user identifier (e.g. account #) in Column B, and a unique site identifier (e.g. site ID) in Column C. If you use one identifier that tracks this data together, please include that in Column B and ignore Column C.

If you prefer, you can anonymize all identifying fields prior to sending us the data.

What are we getting at? The evaluation team uses the unique combination of end user and site to track move ins/outs and distill billing data to the relevant combination of end user and site. If you have a parameter that tracks Move Ins/Outs directly, please provide that in Column K.

If instead you need more than two fields to do this, please feel free to add columns.

What's the format? Please use a new row for each monthly or bi-monthly meter read. Please keep all your billing data for a specific measure on one tab.

Why do we need address? We will use the site address to link your data back to the projects reported into BPA's IS2.0 system.

Save time answering our follow-up questions! On the 'Quick Data Clarifications' tab, please provide the requested information to help us more quickly understand and better utilize your billing data. This data can be provided one time for all projects and measures for which you are providing billing data.

Tracking Move Ins & Move Outs

What we DO want:



Billing data for the unique combination of the sampled **end user** and the **site** at which the measure was installed

What we DON'T want:



Billing data for the sampled site **before or after** the participating end user lived there



Billing data for the participating end user at a different site
