# Slice Update

### **Product Design**

#### Product design:

- BPA will offer a Day-Ahead
  Slice product.
- See the core product design outlined in the July 8 workshop.



#### **Threshold for Offer**

#### Threshold for offer:

- No minimum threshold of participation required to offer a Slice product contract.
- Maximum threshold remains 25% of power sold at a Tier 1 rate.

### Cost Assignment



#### Cost assignment:

- With no minimum threshold, BPA cannot be assured that offering the Slice product benefits all customers. Therefore, BPA intends to recover Slice-related costs from Slice customers.
- BPA is evaluating appropriate cost assignment approaches.

# Changing Purchase Obligation

#### Changing purchase obligation (product switch):

- BPA is evaluating costs associated with product switches; the goal is to insulate customers from cost exposure as a result of others' choices.
- If participation goes to zero, then BPA will retire product.

# Day-ahead market settlement methodology:

 BPA will develop contract language committing to revisit day-ahead market financial settlement methodology.


# Next Up

### Progress + Planning

- Almost 20% of the contract has been workshopped to-date on a section-by-section basis.
  - Milestone: First informal "Draft Contract Template" release by end of October that incorporates all contract sections workshopped through that point in time.
- BPA is on track to release final contract templates for public comment in March 2025 (4 week comment period).
- Currently planning several intensive public workshops for January and February 2025 (pre-comment period) and May 2025 (post-comment period) to iron out final contract language.
  - 3-day intensive sessions; in-person attendance strongly encouraged.


