Net Requirements Transparency Process for Slice/Block and Block Customers Description of Changes and a Response to Comments September 30, 2014

As part of its Net Requirements Transparency process, on July 31, 2014 BPA published the Slice/Block and Block customers' FY2013 and forecast FY2015 Total Retail Load (TRL) and Dedicated Resource data. A review and comment period followed, which was closed on August 14, 2014.

During the comment period, Snohomish submitted an updated TRL energy and peak forecast for January 2015 – September 2015. The updated amounts incorporated specific unanticipated events that had occurred in Snohomish's distribution system. The updated TRL energy forecast was decreased by 6 annual aMW and the TRL peak forecast amounts decreased between $1.5~\mathrm{MW}-2.5~\mathrm{MW}$ per month.
