Public Engagement Processes and Timelines

1. Residential Purchase and Sale Agreements (RPSAs).

- Develop contract terms and implementation provisions for the post-2028 period.

Timeframe	Event
September-November 2025	Workshops to develop RPSA terms
November-December 2025	RPSA Template released for comment
February 2026	RPSA Final ROD and Offers
March 2026	Execution of RPSAs

2. Average System Costs Methodology (ASCM).

- Update the 2008 ASCM to comport with new RPSA terms and to current industry practices.

Timeframe	Event
October – December 2025	Workshops to review ASCM terms
January – February 2026	Draft ASCM open for comment (30 days)
March 2026	Final ASCM and ASCM ROD
April 2026	File ASCM with FERC

3. 7(b)(2) Legal Interpretation and Implementation Methodology.

- Conduct a 7(i) proceeding to develop legal interpretation and IM prior to FY 2029.

Timeframe	Event
April-June 2026	Workshops to review 7(b)(2) IM/LI
July 2026	Begin Section 7(i) on Section 7(b)(2) IM/LI
January 2027	Final IM/LI on Section 7(b)(2) and ROD

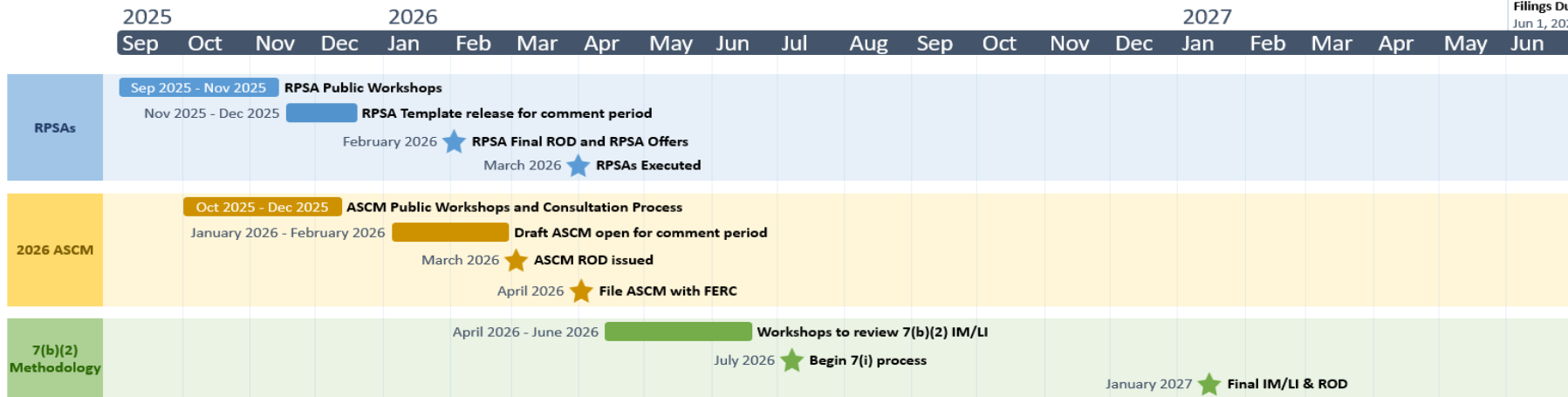
