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### Subject Description:

BPA has issued a [letter to regional parties](#) participating in the Post-2028 Residential Exchange Program (REP) public process. This letter is a follow up to the workshop held on July 28, 2025, regarding the [Post-2028 REP Comprehensive Plan](#). At the workshop, BPA identified two different timeline options for the Residential Purchase and Sale Agreement and the Average System Cost Methodology processes. BPA will adopt the option 1 timeline, which runs from September 2025 through April 2026.

### Background:

Section 5(c) of the Northwest Power Act establishes the REP, which gives residential and farm consumers of regional utilities, primarily investor-owned utilities, access to the economic benefits of the low-cost federal hydropower system. The REP is currently administered pursuant to a settlement agreement that expires Sept. 30, 2028.

BPA is moving forward with transparency and structured stakeholder engagement to ensure legal, operational and ratepayer certainty in delivering REP benefits post 2028.

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
