


Background

- In TC-25 Settlement, BPA agreed to host a stakeholder workshop on Facilities Study and Environmental Study Process.
 - BPA held workshop on Environmental Requirements for Interconnection on February 22, available on the <u>TC-25 Tariff Settlement Commitments page</u>.
- BPA, prior to 2023, performed preliminary engineering/concept design activities during the FAS.
 - Capital Investment Acquisition Process (CIAP) project scoping phase.
- FAS durations increased due to the large increase in interconnection requests, backlog of projects, and BPA resource constraints.
- Customers/developers asked BPA to explore ways to reduce FAS durations and be more responsive.

Improvements

- Preliminary engineering/concept design activities during the CIAP project scoping phase were removed from the FAS.
- Instead, the BPA Planning organization consults with the Engineering organization to refine the plan-ofservice identified in previous studies.

- Small team from Engineering provides consistent FAS input.

 Deferred process steps and concept design to after FAS phase.

Milestones

• Refine the plan-of-service via the Project Requirements Diagram (PRD).


- Feedback is solicited from numerous organizations.

- Site visit.
- Generate site-specific estimates.
- Prepare report, deliver to customer/developer and schedule review meeting.

Results

- Significantly reduced duration of FAS.
- Higher level estimates and results offset by contingency when needed.
- Supports customer/developer requests for BPA to more responsive.
- Customers/developers receive a cost and schedule sooner, leading to contracts for environmental work, engineering and material procurement activities.
