Re: Comments of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. Regarding NITS Access to Transmission Capacity Initial Alternatives

Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") submits the following comments on the BPA March 7, 2025 presentation on NITS Access to Transmission Capacity Initial Alternatives.<sup>1</sup>

BPA has requested comments by March 19, 2025. However, it is unclear what the scope of proposed changes to existing and future point-to-point services include and how BPA would implement the proposed changes. Therefore, —

- (i) BPA should clarify and elaborate if the existing approach to bridge conditional firm and long-term firm point-to-point service offerings is fundamentally changing to lessen or remove certainty of perpetual transmission service offerings via renewed service.
- (ii) BPA should confirm that the proposed changes do not apply to existing transmission service agreements for bridge conditional or long-term firm point-to-point service, nor subsequent transmission service agreements executed for the renewal of the existing transmission service.
- (iii) BPA should confirm that any renewal limitations associated with any new original transmission service will be explicitly noted in the associated transmission service agreement. In the absence of a reference to any renewal limitation, PSE assumes that the existing transmission service offering can be renewed into perpetuity.
