Presentation and Discussion:

The purpose of this meeting is to get utility and other stakeholder feedback on BPA's proposed approach for developing a regional baseline library. BPA will present options for consideration and discuss feedback on the process (when, how and other logistics) for managing the implementation a regional baseline library. We will also share key takeaways from the June 8th technical meeting with CPA consultants, NEEA and Council staff. Desired attendees for this meeting include utility staff who manage CPAs, Council staff, NEEA planning staff, other interested stakeholders.

Additional Background:

During the fall of 2014, BPA customer utilities requested that BPA begin to report Momentum Savings to utilities. Since this time, BPA has been exploring the technical details necessary to do so. One of the major technical issues is around inconsistencies in baselines.

To facilitate better transparency in baselines and assist in baseline alignment, in early 2016 BPA proposed developing a baseline library in collaboration with public utilities and regional energy-efficiency organizations. This library would facilitate transparent baseline alignment and provide a technical resource for utilities to consider using in their Conservation Potential Assessments (CPA). The comments we received through our public comment process showed support for BPA proceeding with this effort.

In response to stakeholder comments, BPA committed to holding a technical prep meeting with the CPA consultants to explore any unforeseen technical challenges. (This technical meeting took place on June 8th). We also committed to having a second meeting including the utilities and other key stakeholders to present our proposed approach to the region and discuss the process.
