New entry level housing and housing built in areas where natural gas is unavailable are often constructed with electric zone heating systems. These systems are initially inexpensive but often saddle homeowners with high utility bills. Hybrid ductless heat pump systems offer a solution to this problem at surprisingly low incremental cost. This webinar will examine the incremental costs, savings and homeowner experiences with hybrid DHP systems in a development of new sustainably built homes.

Bruce Carter from Tacoma Power presents information from the study, which is a collaborative effort between Bonneville Power Administration, Tacoma Power, Snohomish PUD, Cowlitz County PUD, WSU Energy Program, and Tacoma Pierce County Habitat for Humanity.
