

Unassigned Account Allocations

Initial Allocations as of Dec. 11, 2014

On Nov. 13 BPA notified customers of an Unassigned Account distribution of approximately \$3.66 million. As of the Dec. 4 deadline BPA received 70 requests. This is the first distribution that we will be conducting via the new methodology agreed upon during the Post 2011 review in which allocations will be made using a weighted TOCA basis. Initial allocations, inclusive of any conditional maximum amounts indicated are listed below.
