

Main Changes to UES Measure List Format

Recently BPA conducted a survey on proposed changes to the UES Measure List format. We are pleased to announce that most respondents favored eliminating the majority of the changes that were proposed. As a result of the input we received, BPA will eliminate 25 columns of data from the UES Measure List effective October 1, 2015.

We chose to eliminate the columns that the majority of respondents (> 70%) favored removing as well as two other columns (Specification/Requirements and RTF Sunset Date).

Specification / Requirements: This column is duplicative with the information contained within the Implementation Manual. It is difficult to provide sufficient information to make this a comprehensive listing of specifications and requirements in a spreadsheet format. The Implementation Manual will be referenced for specifications and requirements instead.

RTF Sunset Date: The RTF updates sunset dates on a monthly basis and that information is available on the RTF website, however BPA is unable to update the UES Measure List on a monthly basis.
