Heat Pump Water Heaters Capture Nearly 1.5 Million kWh Savings for the Region -

As of April 6, 2014, 1,350 heat pump water heaters have been reimbursed by BPA. These new installations represent nearly 1.5 million kWh savings captured for the region. The program experienced a 300% increase in installed units from FY2012 to FY2013.
