NEW! Updated Option 1 Custom Project Calculator and Summarizer Released -

BPA is pleased to announce the release of version 3.2 of the Option 1 Custom Project Calculator and the Summarizer Tool – both posted to the bpa.gov/ee website under [Interim Solution 2.0 Files](#). These updates correct some errors identified by our customers and incompatibility issues with the reporting system. Please use version 3.2 of the Custom Project Calculator for all new custom projects going forward. As a reminder, any pending project on a retired calculator may still be submitted, but it will need a BPA manual adjustment in order for it to be accepted by IS2 at the time of invoicing.
