

Detailed Instructions: Non-Reportable Deemed Measures & Custom Projects

These instructions are supplemental to the existing instructions for the Deemed Measure Upload Template and the Option 2 Custom Project Calculator Instructions. For reportable data, please follow the current instructions. If you wish to incorporate non-reportable data into the Deemed Measure Upload Template or report Custom Projects using the Option 2 Custom Project Calculator, please refer to the instructions below.

Deemed Measure Upload Template

The following instructions apply to this Excel spreadsheet and are in addition to the existing instructions for the Deemed Measure Upload Template. It can be used to report DEEMED, BPA QUALIFIED and NON-REPORTABLE measures. In addition, you can use this form to report NEEA direct and indirect savings.

Instructions for Non-Reportable Savings

1. Save this spreadsheet making sure the file name complies with the File Naming Tool convention.
2. Using the [Reference Deemed Measure List](#) measure list locate the reference number of the measure you will be entering.
3. If the measure is not on the Reference Deemed Measure List, you can use one of the follow six generic reference numbers to report your savings:

1. AXX40192	Agricultural
2. CXX20415	Commercial
3. IXX30096	Industrial
4. OXX60001	NEEA Direct Savings
5. OXX60002	NEEA Indirect Savings
6. RXX11903	Residential
4. You must select "Non-Reportable" as the funding source for all generic reference numbers.
5. Enter all required information for the measure you are recording. To report non-reportable activity, the following columns must be completed:
 - a. Columns B – Funding Source (Non-Reportable)
 - b. Column C – Reference Number, from the Deemed Measure List or one of the six generic reference numbers listed above
 - c. Column D – Quantity, allows the calculation of total savings based upon the per-unit savings of the measure. For NEEA, enter a value of '1' in this column and the total site savings in Column R, Calculator Savings Per Unit.
 - d. Column E – Completion Date, the date the non-reportable measure was completed.
 - e. Column R – Calculator Savings Per Unit, allows the calculation of total savings. Only utilize this field if you are using one of the above listed generic Reference Numbers. Enter Site Savings values in this field. As noted in item 'c' above, enter total NEEA site savings in this column.
 - f. OPTIONAL: Column S – Calculator Reimbursement Per Unit, allows the calculation of cost per unit for non-reportable measures. Only utilize this field if you are using one of the above listed generic Reference Numbers and you want to calculate a Utility Incentive Cost per Measure on the Activity Report.
6. If a standard BPA Deemed Measure is selected, the Activity Report will show the defined Measure Name. If you use Column P, Wildcard, to populate a program name, the Wildcard is shown as the Measure Name.

7. Submit this spreadsheet along with the other detailed sheets in your monthly invoice package.

Option 2 Custom Project Calculator

The following instructions apply to this Excel spreadsheet and are in addition to the existing instructions for the Option 2 Custom Project Calculator Template. It can be used to report NON-REPORTABLE custom projects.

Instructions for Non-Reportable Savings

1. Save this spreadsheet making sure the file name complies with the File Naming Tool convention.
2. All required fields are identified within the calculator as shown below:

3. For Option 2 users, please follow the “Option 2 Required Fields” for reportable data to BPA. Non-reportable data may be included by following the “Non-Reportable Required Fields” and instruction #5 below.
4. For Option 1 users, please follow the “Non-Reportable Required Fields” (highlighted in red above) and instruction #5 below.
5. In the Funding and Input Summary Tab, Column C – Non-Reportable to BPA, please select “No.” In Column D – Percentage of EEI Funding, please enter “0.”

Other Non-Reportable savings types, such as lighting calculators, energy management calculators or compressed air can be reported as either deemed or custom, using the processes described above.
