

# Eligible Heat Pump Water Heater Models

## General Electric

General Electric Models start with GE and must have a "J" or "K" as the ninth character; the other characters can be anything and the last 1 to 3 might be blank. On the Geospring Water heaters the model label is about two feet to the right and below the control panel.

If the ninth character is D, F, or H or they were installed before 2015, they will not work for this pilot. The most common acceptable models start with these 8 characters, the ninth character must be J or K.
