**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE  
BY THE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF

Pursuant to the Federal Register Notice published on November 8, 2012, 77 Fed. Reg. 66,966 (2010) and the Bonneville Power Administration’s Rules of Procedures Governing Rate Hearings, 52 Fed Reg. 7,611 (1985), the Public Utility District No. 1 of Benton County, Washington (“District”) files this petition for leave to intervene in the above captioned matters as a party of right. In support of this petition, the following information is provided.

**I.**

The District currently purchases wholesale power and transmission services from the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) under rates that will be affected by the proposed adjustments, and will continue to do so during the period when the rates that will be established in this proceeding are in effect.
