**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE
BY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF
FRANKLIN COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

Pursuant to the Federal Register Notice published on November 8, 2012, and the Bonneville Power Administration’s Rules of Procedures Governing Rate Hearings, 52 Fed Reg. 7611 (1985), Public Utility District No. 1 of Franklin County, Washington (the “District”) files this Petition For Leave To Intervene in the above captioned matter as a party of right. In support of this petition, the following information is provided.

I.

The District currently purchases wholesale power, transmission, and ancillary and control area services from the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) under rates that will be affected by the proposed rate adjustments, and will continue to do so during the period when the proposed rate adjustments, if adopted by the Administrator, will be in effect.

II.

The rates that the District will pay to BPA for wholesale power, transmission, and ancillary and control area services will be affected by the proposed rate adjustments and will by extension directly affect the end-use consumers served by the District. No other party to this proceeding will adequately represent the interests of the District.
